1. CONTRACT FOR SPACE

The exhibit space contract properly executed by Applicant (Exhibitor) is subject to formal notice of acceptance by Show Management of Geo-Frontiers 2011, and when so accepted, upon full payment of the exhibit space, rates shall constitute a contract for the right to use the space, subject to all conditions, terms and regulations set forth herein. IFAI will act in good faith to respect the booth location preference of the exhibitor but maintains the sole right to reassign space based on the overall good of the association or conference, and further reserves the right to reject any application without assigning cause therefore. Exhibitor agrees to abide by all rules and restrictions of this event and the city and center in which it is located.

2. PAYMENT FOR SPACE

Full payment or non-refundable deposit of 50% of exhibit space rates (U.S. Funds) must accompany the Geo-Frontiers 2011 space contract for assignment of space. To be eligible for the member rate, the exhibitor must be a member in good standing throughout the duration of the conference. Should an exhibitor's membership lapse, the nonmember rate will be due prior to the installation dates as stated in the Rules & Regulations. All contracted exhibit space must be paid in full by 8 January 2011. All monies owed must be paid in full prior to being allowed on the show floor. Any past due invoices (e.g. advertising, material sales, etc.) that the exhibitor has with these organizations must be paid three weeks before attending Geo-Frontiers 2011 or the booth space and any payment received for the booth will be forfeited. Forfeited booth space payments will not be applied to other outstanding invoices.

3. CANCELLATION & REDUCTION CHARGES

In the event of a cancellation or reduction of space by the Exhibitor, an assessment to cover service performed and other damages related to the action shall be as follows:

REDUCTION OF SPACE

Prior to 8 January 2011	After 8 January 2011
25% of total exhibit space rate	75% of exhibit space rate

CANCELLATION DURING THE PERIOD OF

On or before 8 January 2011	After 8 January 2011
50% of the space rate	100% of the space rate

It is understood that IFAI or G-I reserves the right, at their option, to reassign cancelled booths regardless of the cancellation rate assessed. Subsequent reassignment of cancelled space does not relieve the cancelling Exhibitor of his obligation to pay the amount referred to above.

4. LIABILITY

Exhibitor agrees that IFAI, G-I or NAGS shall not be liable for any damage or liability of any kind, including content of display or literature, or for any damage or injury to person or property during the term of this agreement from any cause whatsoever by reason of use, occupation or enjoyment of exhibit space by Exhibitor or any person thereon with the consent of Exhibitor, and that Exhibitor will indemnify and hold harmless IFAI, G-I or NAGS from all liability whatsoever, including all litigation expenses, court costs and attorney fees, on account of any such damage, or injury, whether or not caused by negligence or breach of an obligation by Exhibitor or its employees or representatives.

5. STRIKES, FIRE AND ACTS OF GOD

IFAI, G-I and NAGS reserve the right to change the location or cancel the exhibition in the event of a strike, fire, war, government regulation, disaster, civil disorder, curtailment of transportation facilities, or Act of God that would render the hall in which the event has been scheduled unusable. No refunds of exhibit space will be distributed until the IFAI, G-I or NAGS Board of Directors /Governors or Senior Management have officially declared in writing the event has been cancelled.

6. PENALTIES

IFAI or G-I may impose penalties for noncompliance of rules and regulations set forth herein and in the Exhibitor Information and Services Manual. Penalties imposed will be at the discretion of IFAI or G-I and based on the severity of the infraction to include, but not limited to, immediate expulsion from the exposition, or exclusion from future IFAI or G-I sponsored expositions.
